- **Make money selling biodiesel and E85 while avoiding the pitfalls**
- **Successfully implement one or both of these fuels in your fleet operation**
- **Effectively promote increased usage and availability where you live**

**The American Jobs Creation Act (AJCA)** of 2004 was passed by Congress then signed by President Bush on October 22, 2004. It provides a brand-new excise tax credit for soy biodiesel worth \$1/gallon of B100 when it is blended with petroleum diesel. The credit is worth \$0.50/gallon for used-feedstock biodiesel. An income tax credit of \$1 or \$0.50/gallon respectively is available to end users of B100. AJCA also simplified the existing tax credit for ethanol, creating new and great advantages for E85. Now E85 blenders can take the full value of the ethanol tax credit, worth about \$0.44/gallon for E85. AJCA took effect January 1, 2005. It will make biodiesel and E85 price competitive with petroleum diesel and regular gasoline.

# DIRECTIONS:

## **April 20 - Raintree Country Club, 4340 Mayfair Road, Uniontown, Ohio**

From North: Take I-77 south to Exit 118, Massillon Road, turn right. Turn left on Graybill Road, then right on Mayfair Road. From South: Take I-77 north to Exit 113. Go toward airport. Turn right on Lauby, right on Greensburg, then left on Mayfair. Travel 1.7 miles.

## **April 21 - Liberty Center, 951 Liberty Drive, Lancaster, Ohio**

Take Rte 33. Turn right (if traveling south) on Collins Road (20 miles south of I-70 in Columbus – just north of Lancaster). Go 1.2 miles and turn right on W. Fair Ave. Go 0.2 miles. Liberty Center will be on your left.

## **June 14 - Der Dutchman, 230 North U.S. Route 42, Waynesville, Ohio**

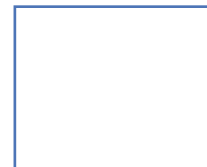

## **June 15 - Simpson Center, 1291 Conneaut Avenue, Bowling Green, Ohio**

Take I-75 to Bowling Green Exit (OH-105/OH-64), go west on E. Wooster Street 2.2 miles, turn right on Haskins Rd, then left on Conneaut Ave. Simpson Building is 0.5 miles ahead.
